

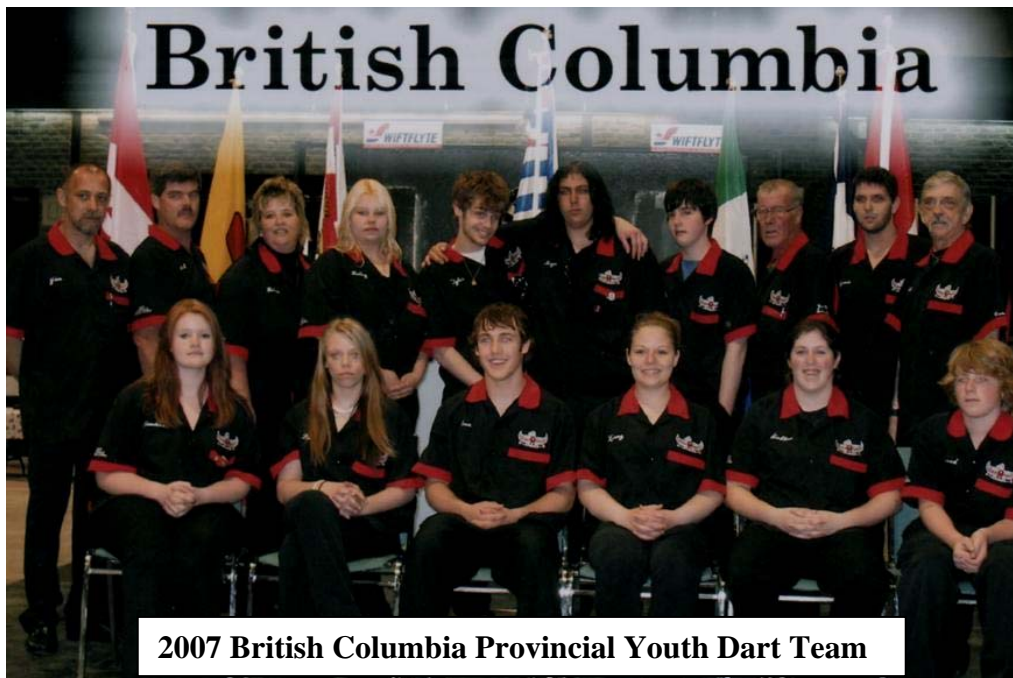

Players must have a shirt with a collar, black dress pants (no jean style, corduroy or denim material), no skirts to be worn during the dart events. Team B.C. did exceptionally well at the 2007 Canadian Nationals in Lachine, Q.C., winning the Gold medal in the Junior Female Singles Event and finalist medals in the Senior Males Singles, Senior Mixed Doubles, and Senior Female Doubles events along with the Female Sportsmanship Award for Canada. We hope to have a repeat performance of the dart skills and sportsmanship displayed throughout the event. We encourage the youth players to bring their guitars and positive attitudes have a little fun getting reacquainted with one another and meeting new players that have joined the various community leagues as they compete to win their place on this year's 2008 B.C. Provincial Youth Team. The Canadian Nationals will be held in Winnipeg, Manitoba this May long weekend and rooms for the B.C. Team have already been secured.

All players competing in the Provincial Playdowns must reside in the Province of B.C. and must be registered with the BCDA/NDFC. Membership cards must be presented at time of registration. If you do not have your card & number you will not be permitted to play in the Provincial Playdowns. Coaches must also have a BCDA/NDFC #.

You should present a completed list of your players that includes their full name, date of birth, phone number, address, city, postal code and coach/parent's contact information.

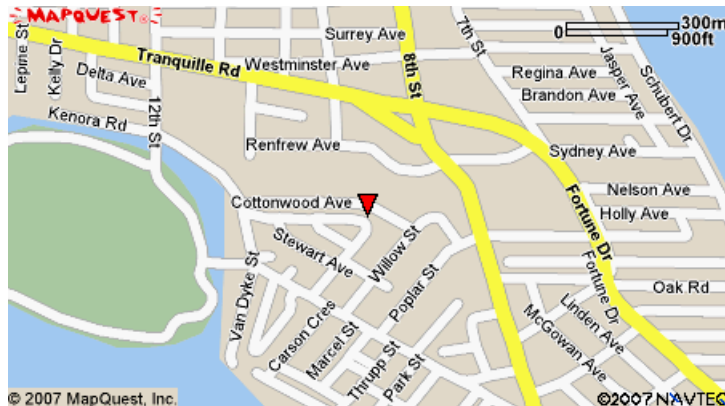
